Beginning at a spike and pile of stones at the West corner of this lot on the Southeast side of Kilohana Avenue, and ^{on} the boundary of Waiakea, the coordinates of which referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Hapai" are 3322.4 feet North and 10346.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2383, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 197° 24' 30" 126.8 feet along Kilohana Avenue to spike and pile of stones;
2. 287° 24' 30" 115.8 feet along Lot 8 to spike and pile of stones;
3. 59° 48' 00" 171.8 feet along Waiakea to the point of beginning.
