Beginning at a 4" x 4" red wood post at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 9D, on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" being 5812.6 feet South and 4937.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 265° 05' 2546.0 feet along Lot 9D to 4" x 4" red wood post;
2. 8° 45' 867.0 feet along Grant 3635 to Kealohaai to a + on set stone and ahu;
3. 90° 39' 2309.0 feet along Lot 9B to 4" x 4" red wood post on the East side of 40 foot road;
4. 167° 25' 205.5 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to a + on set stone;
5. 172° 53' 415.0 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to the point of beginning.
