Lot 10.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of this lot, which is also the Northwest corner of Lot 11, the true azimuth and distance from the Southwest corner of Lot 18, now Grant 4457 to H. A. Swift, being $15^{\circ} 16'$, 172 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1878, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $15^{\circ} 16'$ 3303 feet along Lot 11;
2. $94^{\circ} 55'$ 1037 feet along Government land;
3. $195^{\circ} 16'$ 3770 feet along Lot 9 to 50 foot road;
4. Thence along the South side of 50 foot road to the initial point, the direct azimuth and distance being: $300^{\circ} 39'$, 1058 feet.
