Station "Papapa-holahola" being: 6294.0 feet South and 2576.2 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No= 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 5° 23' 135.1 feet along West side of 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
2. 2° 27' 237.0 feet along West side of 30 foot road to a + on set stone;
3. 110° 48' 735.9 feet along Lot 104 to a + on set stone;
4. 224° 16' 288.7 feet along Reservoir Reserve B to a + on set stone;
5. 196° 28' 102.0 feet along Reservoir Reserve B to a + on set stone;
6. 292° 09' 518.0 feet along Lot 102 to the point of beginning.
