KAUPAKUEA HOMESTEADS,
South Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 11, and on the North side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 1625.0 feet North, and 6994.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2546, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $69^{\circ} 37'$ 276.3 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road;
2. $75^{\circ} 54'$ 387.9 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road;
3. $161^{\circ} 30'$ 979.3 feet along Lot 9;
4. Thence along the middle of Kapehu Stream to a point, the direct azimuth and distance being, $242^{\circ} 27'$ 671.2 feet;
5. $341^{\circ} 30'$ 1105.6 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning.
