Beginning at a pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 9 and on the South side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1676.7 feet North and 4732.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 357° 33' 954.9 feet along Lot 9 to a post on the boundary of Papaikou;
2. 93° 30' 770.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a pipe;
3. 116° 30' 557.5 feet along the land of Papaikou to a pipe on the South side of homestead road;
4. 278° 21' 330.6 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
5. 232° 44' 225.45 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
6. 218° 25' 155.55 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
7. 205° 41' 357.0 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
8. 250° 19' 277.2 feet along homestead road to a pipe;
9. 260° 17' 213.7 feet along homestead road to the point of beginning.
