tered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 30' 850.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve;
2. 118° 30' 876.7 feet along Lot 9 to a post on the East bank of
Kilau Gulch;
3. Along the East bank of Kilau Gulch, the direct azimuth and dis-
tance being: 204° 46' 850.5 feet to a
post on bank;
4. 298° 30' 932.7 feet along Lot 13 to the point of beginning.
