Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 104, and on the East side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 2175.73 feet South and 6010.44 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 176° 51' 156.5 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
2. 153° 26' 184.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
3. 130° 51' 279.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
4. 164° 16' 215.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road;
5. 215° 34' 107.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 298° 04' 1477.9 feet along Lot 106 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 359° 57' 93.0 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
8. 37° 7' 30" 143.3 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
9. 9° 49' 52.1 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch;
10. 15° 36' 282.8 feet along near West edge of Kilau Gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
11. 117° 9' 30" 939.4 feet along Lot 104 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom all that piece or parcel

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of land varying from ten (10) to forty (40) feet in width, which variation shall be governed by the contour of said land so that sufficient width shall be allowed to provide for the construction and maintenance of a cane flume, not exceeding four (4) feet in width with necessary trestle work to support the same, said right-of-way crossing the Northwestern portion of this lot, containing an area of $11/100$ acres, a little more or less, LEAVING A NET AREA OF $15-91/100$ Acres.
