Beginning at a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 9, and on the North side of Uweki Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 6737.3 feet South and 5881.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $140^{\circ} 40'$  656.0 feet along North side of Uweki Road to a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe;
2.  $226^{\circ} 54'$  991.4 feet along Lots 11 and 8 to a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe;
3.  $321^{\circ} 11'$  645.7 feet along Lot 6 to a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch galvanized iron pipe;
4.  $46^{\circ} 16'$  986.4 feet along Lot 9 to the point of beginning.
