



Beginning at the north corner of this lot, at an angle in the northwest boundary of L.C. Aw. 4848-F, Apana 2 to Maewaewa 1, and on the southeast boundary of L.C. Aw. 4848-C to Keliaaea, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Keanae Uka" being 1828.2 feet North and 1673.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2238, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 291° 40' 80.5 feet along L.C. Aw. 4848-F, Apana 2 to Maewaewa 1;
2. 19° 30' 33.7 feet along same;
3. 112° 40' 81.7 feet along L.C. Aw. 4856, Apana 2 to Kaihu;
4. 201° 33' 32.3 feet along L.C. Aw. 4848-C to Keliaaea to the point of beginning.
