Beginning at a 4" x 4" red wood post at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 10C, on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" being 8862.8 feet South and 4887.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 198° 50' 75.3 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to a + on set stone;
2. 174° 31' 290.0 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to a + on set stone;
3. 180° 17' 495.0 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to 4" x 4" red wood post;
4. 270° 39' 2211.5 feet along Lot 9A to a + on set stone and ahu;
5. 4° 16' 868.0 feet along Grant 3635 to Kealohaai to 4" x 4" red wood post;
6. 90° 57' 2147.0 feet along Lot 10C to the point of beginning.
