Puukapu, Waimea, South Kohala, Hawaii.

Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 112 and on the South side of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 6691.8 feet North and 2144.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $346^{\circ} 10'$  3086.4 feet along Lot 112 to a mamane post;
2.  $76^{\circ} 10'$  600.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3.  $166^{\circ} 10'$  3077.1 feet along Lot 108 to a mamane post;
4.  $256^{\circ} 58'$  281.0 feet along the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5.  $253^{\circ} 50'$  319.2 feet along the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
