Beginning at a + on set stone at the North corner of this lot, and the West corner of Lot 10, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Secondary Trig. Station "Pohakupuka" (marked by a  $\Delta$  on a large rock on the boundary between the lands of Lalamilo and Lahui-puaa) being 1317.5 feet North and 978.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2993, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. 320° 40' 435.6 feet along Lot 10, and passing over a + on set stone at 119.3 feet;
2. 50° 40' 300.0 feet along government land;
3. 140° 40' 435.6 feet along Lot 12 to a + on set stone, and passing over a + on set stone at 246.6 feet;
4. 230° 40' 300.0 feet along Government Reserve to the point of beginning.
