Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot the North corner of Lot 109 and on the West side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 526.92 feet North and 5006.04 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 203° 22' 296.0 feet along near East edge of Laupahoehoe Gulch;
2. 213° 02' 499.3 feet along near East edge of Laupahoehoe Gulch;
3. 231° 23' 283.9 feet along near East edge of Laupahoehoe Gulch;
4. 328° 36' 789.0 feet along West side of Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 33° 36' 115.0 feet along West side of Homestead Road;
6. 11° 32' 153.0 feet along West side of Homestead Road;
7. 355° 55' 105.0 feet along West side of Homestead Road;
8. 114° 02' 435.0 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
9. 140° 53' 352.0 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
10. 47° 2' 30" 431.7 feet along West side of Homestead Road to the point of beginning.
