Revised Description.

Lot 112.

Manowaiopae Homesteads,
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 114, and on the North side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 4165.3 feet South and 9091.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 33° 16' 18.6 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
2. 85° 50' 342.1 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
3. 13° 07' 135.6 feet along West side of Homestead Road;
4. 8° 23' 80.0 feet along West side of Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 95° 00' 75.0 feet along North side of Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 209° 36' 115.0 feet along Grant 4146 to F. Licente to a Δ mark in ohia tree;
7. 86° 12' 148.0 feet along Grant 4146 to F. Licente;
8. 56° 40' 136.2 feet along Grant 4146 to F. Licente;
9. 95° 00' 372.3 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
10. 208° 35' 673.0 feet along East side of Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
11. 298° 35' 822.9 feet along South side of Homestead Road and along Lot 114 to the point of beginning.
