Beginning at an iron rail at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 12 and on the North side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being ~~19181.5~~^{19189.2} feet North and ~~8603.1~~^{8592.4} feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ~~2382~~²⁵⁷⁴, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 146° 36' 570.5 feet along Lot 12 to an iron rail;
2. 236° 55' 831.0 feet along Lots 5 and 4 to an iron rail;
3. 326° 55' 630.0 feet along Lot 10 to an iron rail on the North side of 40 foot road;
4. 61° 15' 630.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
5. 60° 20' 200.0 feet along 40 foot road to the point of beginning.
