Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 10 and on the boundary of Papaikou, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 18019.5 feet South and 622.4 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2447, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 91° 00' 350.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a pipe;
2. 102° 15' 1472.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a pipe;
3. Thence down the middle of Puuokalepa Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 260° 27' 993.0 feet to a pipe;
4. 295° 00' 400.0 feet along Lot 8 to a pipe;
5. 243° 26' 358.2 feet along Lot 8 to a pipe;
6. 345° 05' 490.7 feet along homestead road, along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.

Area 11-48/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving Puuokalepa and Kumuhawane Streams and all riparian and other rights in or to these streams and the waters thereof.
