Beginning at a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 112, and on the North side of Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being ~~4175.0~~^{4165.3} feet South and ~~9103.7~~^{9091.3} feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 118° 35' 1399.2 feet along Lot 112 across Homestead Road and along Lot 113 to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 211° 40' 190.0 feet along Grant 4161 to George Kittle;
3. 260° 47' 340.0 feet along Grant 4161 to George Kittle;
4. 298° 35' 1153.0 feet along Lot 115 crossing Homestead Road to a 2-1/2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 33° 16' 399.2 feet along West side of Homestead Road to the point of beginning.

Area 12-20/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a strip of land 30 feet wide across this lot for a public road, said road strip containing an area of 56/100 Acres.

Also excepting and reserving a right-of-way 15 feet wide for a proposed flume over this lot, which said flume will be parallel to the road reserve, (area 28/100 acre).
