Beginning at a pipe at the Southwest corner of this lot, the Southeast corner of Lot 12 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2431.6 feet North and 2400.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 173° 39' 607.0 feet along Lot 12 to a post, the same being 10 feet from the edge of ~~the~~ stream;
2. Easterly on a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: 272° 39' 1188.3 feet;
3. 354° 50' 146.5 feet along West side of a Government Reserve to a pipe on the North side of homestead road;
4. 83° 08' 359.5 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
5. 77° 13' 341.7 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
6. 57° 27' 527.5 feet along North side of homestead road to the point of beginning.
