Beginning at a post marked XI-XII at the North corner of this lot and on the East side of road reserve, the coordinates of said point being: 4565.6 feet South and 9056.2 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 298° 30' 1265.0 feet along Lot 12 to a post on the bank of Mangwaiepae Gulch;
2. Along the West bank of said gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 55° 09' 1973.0 feet;
3. 118° 30' 380.5 feet along Government land to a post at road;
4. 208° 30' 1763.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to the point of beginning.

Area 35-23/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a strip of land 50 feet wide across this lot for a public road, said road strip containing an area of 1-42/100 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 33-81/100 ACRES.
