Beginning at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 10, and on the North side of Lepoloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina/^(Old)" being 2354.1 feet South and 2651.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 67° 44' 30" 541.0 feet along North side of Lepoloa Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 157° 45' 1260.6 feet along Lot 12 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 233° 50' 363.5 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 258° 14' 191.4 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 337° 45' 1313.2 feet along Lot 10 to the point of beginning.
