Beginning at a post at the East corner of this lot at a point adjoining the road reserve, the coordinates of which point being: 4271.8 feet South and 4300.7 feet West, of the Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2381, and running by true azimuths:

1. 52° 24' 736.5 feet along road reserve;
2. 16° 40' 270.2 feet along road reserve;
3. 49° 38' 700.0 feet along road reserve;
4. 88° 35' 343.0 feet along road reserve;
5. 116° 25' 162.0 feet along road reserve;
6. 161° 17' 670.0 feet along road reserve and along Lot 12 to  marked on boulder in stream;
7. Down center of stream to  on stone at junction with Honohina Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being: 239° 40' 1024.0 feet;
8. Down center of Honohina Stream to  on boulder, the direct azimuth and distance being: 220° 14' 797.5 feet;
9. 312° 40' 565.5 feet up bank and along Grant 2999 to Niau to center of small gulch;
10. 343° 00' 290.0 feet along Lot 8 to the point of beginning.
