Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 12 on the East side of the Waiohuli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-O-Kali" being; 8869.4 feet South and 15714.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 200° 25' 210.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
2. 218° 30' 131.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
3. 202° 02' 244.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
4. 219° 16' 139.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
5. 309° 46' 1514.0 feet along Lot 10 to a mamane post on the boundary of the mauka pasture lands;
6. 39° 46' 700.0 feet along the mauka pasture lands to a mamane post;
7. 129° 46' 1366.8 feet along Lot 12 to the point of beginning.
