Beginning at a pipe at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 121, and on the top edge of the gulch, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Piipholo" being 6927.0 feet South and 2443.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2394, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $54^{\circ} 45'$ 2117.0 feet along Lot 121 to the middle of a gulch, said point being: $234^{\circ} 45'$ 10.0 feet from a pipe on the West bank of the stream;
2. Thence down the middle of the gulch along Lot 110 to the North corner of Lot 110 the direct azimuth and distance being: $124^{\circ} 58'$ 516.5 feet, said point being: $234^{\circ} 45'$ 10.0 feet from a pipe on the West bank of the stream.
3. Thence still down the middle of the gulch along Lot 111 to the South corner of Lot 119 the direct azimuth and distance being: $140^{\circ} 30'$ 295.4 feet said point being $54^{\circ} 45'$ 10.0 feet from a pipe on the East bank of the stream;
4. $234^{\circ} 45'$ 2424.0 feet along Lot 119 to a pipe on the top edge of a gulch, passing over a pipe at 10.0 feet;
5. Thence along the top edge of the gulch to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being: $332^{\circ} 48'$ 788.0 feet.

Area 41-10/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the homestead road through this lot, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, containing an area of 1-52/100 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 39-58/100 ACRES.
