Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, on the South side of Lower Kalopa Road, and on the West side of the Gravity Railroad right-of-way (100 feet wide), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kalanial" being 4507.8 feet North and 26.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2586, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $23^{\circ} 33'$ 870.0 feet along Gravity Railroad right-of-way to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $113^{\circ} 33'$ 925.0 feet along Lot 15 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $203^{\circ} 33'$ 870.0 feet along East side of Lower Kalopa Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $293^{\circ} 33'$ 925.0 feet along South side of Lower Kalopa Road to the point of beginning.
