Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 11 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2431.6 feet North and 2400.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 70° 01' 629.9 feet along North side of homestead road to a post;
2. 78° 02' 141.2 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
3. 173° 39' 824.7 feet along Lot 13 to a post 10 feet from the edge of ~~the~~ stream;
4. Easterly on a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post in a pile of stones, the direct azimuth and distance being:
267° 51' 754.3 feet;
5. 353° 39' 607.0 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning.
