Kiolakaa-Keaa Homestead Lots,

Kau, Hawaii.

Lot 12.

Beginning at "Haleola" Trig. Station (marked by a \blacktriangle on set stone and ahu), the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" being 20572.5 feet South and 6510.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ²¹⁷⁶2197, and running by true bearings:-

1. N $12^{\circ} 25'$ W 1040.0 feet along road reserve;
2. N $7^{\circ} 27'$ W ~~2907.0~~ feet along stone wall along road reserve;
3. N $30^{\circ} 15'$ W 350.0 feet along road reserve;
4. S $85^{\circ} 19'$ E 986.0 feet along Lot 11 to \dagger on stone;
5. Due South 745.0 feet along L.C.A. 8542 to Kechokalole to ahu;
6. S $14^{\circ} 11'$ E 1457.0 feet along same to ahu;
7. S $15^{\circ} 40'$ E 915.0 feet along same to ahu;
8. S $20^{\circ} 20'$ E 785.0 feet along same to a small drill hole in rock and ahu at "Na-pumaiia-aKala" Trig. Station;
9. S $36^{\circ} 52'$ E 70.0 feet along same to \dagger on base stone in wall;
10. S $70^{\circ} 22'$ W 1380.0 feet along stone wall along the North side of old Government Road to a point which bears N $70^{\circ} 22'$ E 100.0 feet from a \dagger on base stone in wall on the East line of Grant 2905 to Kamanawai;

11. N 9° 25' E 121.0 feet along road reserve to the point of beginning.

1. S $9^{\circ} 25' W$ 121.0 feet along Lot 12 of the Kiolakaa-Keaa Homestead Lots to stone wall;
2. S $70^{\circ} 22' W$ 100.0 feet along stone wall along the North side of old Government Road to $+$ on base stone in wall;
3. N $60^{\circ} 47' W$ 1170.0 feet along Grant 2905 to Kamanawai to ahu;
4. N $8^{\circ} 51' W$ 2370.0 feet along same to pipe;
5. N $2^{\circ} 46' W$ 904.0 feet along same to $+$ on stone at the Northeast corner of said grant;
6. S $85^{\circ} 19' E$ 40.0 feet;
7. S $3^{\circ} 15' E$ 350.0 feet along Lot 12;
8. S $7^{\circ} 27' E$ 2911.0 feet along Lot 12 along stone wall;
