Station "Papaaloa", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 298° 30' 989.0 feet along Lot 15 to road reserve on the bank of Manowaiopae Gulch;
2. Along the West side of road reserve and the ^{top of the} West bank of Manowaiopae Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 6° 04' 724.7 feet to a post on bank;
3. 118° 30' 1265.0 feet along Lot 11 to a post at road reserve;
4. 208° 30' 670.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to the point of beginning.
