3. $184^{\circ} 58'$ 91.9 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
4. $211^{\circ} 09'$ 183.6 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
5. $273^{\circ} 24'$ 814.1 feet along Lot 11 to a + on stone;
6. $3^{\circ} 24'$ 275.1 feet along Lots 29 and 28 to the point of beginning.
