Beginning at a + on set stone at the West corner of this lot, the true azimuth and distance to Government Survey Secondary Trig. Station "Pohakupuka" (marked by a Δ on large rock on the boundary between the lands of Lalamilo and Lahuipuaa) being $28^{\circ} 45' 30''$ 985.2 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2993, and running by azimuths measured clockwise from true South:-

1. $232^{\circ} 43'$ 236.5 feet along Government Reserve to a + on set stone;
2. $214^{\circ} 59'$ 147.0 feet along same to a + on set stone;
3. $320^{\circ} 40'$ 435.6 feet along Lot 11, and passing over a + on set stone at 189.0 feet;
4. $97^{\circ} 36'$ 553.4 feet along government land to the point of beginning and passing over a + on set stone at 470.1 feet.
