Puukapu Homesteads (Second Series),

Puukapu, Waimea, South Kohala, Hawaii.

Beginning at a mamane post at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 127 and on the North side of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 8083.4 feet North and 7506.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $166^{\circ} 10'$ 2384.0 feet along Lot 127 to a mamane post;
2. $307^{\circ} 57'$ 1512.6 feet along the land of Waikoekoe to a mamane post;
3. $298^{\circ} 44'$ 1513.4 feet along the land of Waikoekoe to a mamane post;
4. $29^{\circ} 41'$ 350.8 feet along the Kukuihaele Branch of the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5. Thence along said Kukuihaele Branch on a curve to the left with a radius of 127.0 feet to a mamane post, the direct azimuth and distance being:- $54^{\circ} 58'$ 108.5 feet; right
6. $80^{\circ} 15'$ 1712.3 feet along the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
