Beginning at a Forest Reserve Monument at the Southeast corner of this lot, and the North corner of Lot 129, and on the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Piihola" being 7783.5 feet South and 4638.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2394, running by true azimuths:-

1. $54^{\circ} 45'$ 1490.5 feet along Lot 129 to a pipe on the top edge of a gulch;
2. Thence down along the top edge of the gulch to a pipe at the South corner of Lot 131, the direct azimuth and distance being: $161^{\circ} 24'$ 887.0 feet;
3. $234^{\circ} 45'$ 2218.0 feet along Lot 131 to a pipe on the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch;
4. Thence up along the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being: $13^{\circ} 51'$ 1298.5 feet.

Area 41-00/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the homestead road through this lot, as shown on plan attached hereto and made a part hereof, containing an area of 1-05/100 Acres; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 39-95/100 ACRES.
