Beginning at a + on rock in stone-wall at the South corner of this lot and on the West side of Government Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuki being 596.8 feet North and 113.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2547, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 141° 15' 286.8 feet along Grant 1923 to Puunui to a + cut on rock on bluff;
2. 105° 45' 220.0 feet along stone-wall along Grant 1923 to Puunui to pile of stones;
3. 115° 00' 233.6 feet along stone-wall along Grant 1923 to Puunui to a + on stone under pile of stones;
4. 106° 26' 1600.6 feet along Grant 1923 to Puunui and along Government land to a + on red stone on top of pali;
5. 100° 02' 50.0 feet along government land; to edge of pali;
6. Thence down along near the South edge of Waiohonu Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being:
271° 29' 30" 763.2 feet to a + cut on boulder;
7. 289° 09' 1666.5 feet along Lot 14 to an arrow → on stone at foot of stone-wall;
8. 28° 24' 314.9 feet along stone-wall along government road to the point of beginning.
