Ahualoa Reserve Remnants,  
Honokaa Section, Hamakua, Hawaii.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 15, Honokaa Section, (Grant 3138 to Coffin), the true azimuth and distance from the Northwest corner of Lot 12, Government Reserve, being:  $195^{\circ} 16' 52.27$  feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1878, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $195^{\circ} 16'$  3700.0 feet along Lot 15, Honokaa Section, (Grant 3138 to Coffin);
2. Thence along the South side of 40 foot road, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $303^{\circ} 18' 206.9$  feet;
3.  $15^{\circ} 16'$  3660.0 feet along Lot 16, Honokaa Section, (Grant 5000 to E. N. Holmes;
4. Thence along the North side of 50 foot road, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $112^{\circ} 14' 198.2$  feet to the point of beginning.
