Puukapu, Waimea, South Kohala, Hawaii.

Beginning at a mamane post at the Northeast corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 133 and on the South side of the Honokaa Branch of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 8008.0 feet North and 9886.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 9° 18' 2733.0 feet along Lot 133 to a mamane post;
2. 76° 10' 109.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. 168° 58' 30" 3019.3 feet along Lot 131 to a mamane post;
4. 260° 15' 375.7 feet along the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5. Thence along the Honokaa Branch of the Government Main Road on a curve to the right with a radius of 515.0 feet, the direct azimuth and distance being:- 273° 22' 233.7 feet to a mamane post;
6. 286° 29' 128.5 feet along said Honokaa Branch to a mamane post;
7. 297° 40' 116.2 feet along said Honokaa Branch to a mamane post;
8. 304° 06' 356.3 feet along said Honokaa Branch to the point of beginning.

Area 42-64/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a Right-of-way 20 feet wide for a ditch across this lot, (area 28/100 acre); LEAVING A NET AREA OF 42-36/100 ACRES.
