Station "East Base" being 7563.0 feet North and 10856.0 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 02' 2653.0 feet along Lot 134 to a mamane post;
2. 118° 44' 186.7 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. 189° 18' 2733.0 feet along Lot 132 to a mamane post;
4. 304° 06' 275.0 feet along the Honokaa Branch of the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5. 291° 24' 797.0 feet along said Honokaa Branch to the point of beginning.
