Beginning at a pipe at the North corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 134, and on the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Piiholo" being 4480.6 feet South and 4260.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2394, and running by true azimuths:

1. Up along the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch to a pipe at the North corner of Lot 132, the direct azimuth and distance being: $299^{\circ} 08'$ 759.5 feet;
2. $54^{\circ} 45'$ 2817.0 feet along Lot 132 to a pipe on the top edge of a gulch;
3. Thence down along the top edge of the gulch to a pipe at the South corner of Lot 134, the direct azimuth and distance being: $157^{\circ} 22'$ 702.0 feet;
4. $234^{\circ} 45'$ 2335.5 feet along Lot 134 to the point of beginning.

Area 41-70/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the homestead roads through this lot, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, containing an area of 1-58/100 Acres; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 40-12/100 ACRES.
