Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 12 and on the boundary of the lands of Kulaimano and Pepeekeo, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 968.3 feet South and 6376.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 298° 29' 460.0 feet along the land of Pepeekeo to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 360° 00' 1329.2 feet along Lot 14 to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 118° 05' 29.6 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 98° 05' 381.5 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 180° 00' 1480.8 feet along Lot 12 to the point of beginning.
