Beginning at a mamane post at the East corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 135 and on the South side of the Honokaa Branch of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 7351.2 feet North and 11424.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 04' 2741.0 feet along Lot 135 to a mamane post;
2. 118° 44' 600.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. 208° 02' 2653.0 feet along Lot 133 to a mamane post;
4. 291° 24' 361.0 feet along the Honokaa Branch of the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5. 290° 18' 233.0 feet along said Honokaa Branch to a mamane post;
6. 265° 08' 14.0 feet along said Honokaa Branch to the point of beginning.
