Beginning at a pipe at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 133, and on the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Piiholo" being 4480.6 feet South and 4260.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2394, and running by true azimuths:

1. $54^{\circ} 45'$ 2335.5 feet along Lot 133 to a pipe on top edge of a gulch;
2. Thence down along the top edge of the gulch to a pipe at the West corner of this lot, the direct azimuth and distance being: $147^{\circ} 22'$ 800.8 feet;
3. $234^{\circ} 45'$ 2315.0 feet along Lot 135 and Government land to a pipe on the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch, passing over a pipe at the East corner of Lot 135 at 2123.0 feet;
4. Thence up along the top edge of Kahakapao Gulch to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being: $325^{\circ} 53'$ 800.2 feet.

Area 42-60/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom the homestead roads through this lot, as shown on plan hereto attached and made a part hereof, containing an area of 1-85/100 Acres; LEAVING A NET AREA OF 40-75/100 ACRES.
