Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 12, and on the North side of Lepoia Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohina/^(Old)" being 2800.4 feet South and 1560.9 feet East, as shown on Registered Map No. 2588, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 67° 44' 30" 651.0 feet along North side of Lepoia Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 149° 24' 1020.8 feet along East side of Mauka Cross Road to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 233° 15' 306.0 feet along Grant 6007 to M. K. Kauhi to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 240° 45' 508.7 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 337° 50' 1148.3 feet along Lot 12 to the point of beginning.
