Station "Paina" being S. 1686.4 feet and E. 360.2 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 195° 36' 178.0 feet along the East bank of Kawaihou Stream and Lots 13 A and 12 A;
2. 203° 52' 88.6 feet along same to Lot 12;
3. 288° 14' 77.7 feet along Lot 12;
4. 5° 02' 18.9 feet along Lot 12;
5. 286° 31' 55.2 feet along Lot 12;
6. 340° 49' 56.7 feet along Lot 12;
7. 9° 12' 142.2 feet along old ~~bank of river~~;
8. 99° 37' 101.8 feet along Lot 14;
9. 5° 46' 33.5 feet along Lot 14;
10. 87° 17' 51.4 feet along Lot 14;
11. 183° 00' 12.6 feet along Lot 14;
12. 97° 36' 50.5 feet along Lot 14 to the initial point.
