Beginning at an arrow → cut on stone at foot of stone-wall at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 13 and on the West side of Government Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuike" being 873.6 feet North and 263.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2547, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $109^{\circ} 09'$  1666.5 feet along Lot 13 to a + cut on boulder;
2. Thence along near the South edge of Waiohonu Stream to bluff, the direct azimuth and distance being:-  
 $269^{\circ} 54'$  1013.6 feet;
3. Thence along near the South edge of Waiohonu Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being:-  $283^{\circ} 24'$  820.0 feet to a + cut in cement near bridge;
4.  $38^{\circ} 16'$  220.0 feet along stone-wall along Government Road;
5.  $28^{\circ} 28' 30''$  211.4 feet along stone-wall along Government Road to the point of beginning.
