Lot 14.

Beginning at a post marking the North angle of this lot at the intersection of roadways, the coordinates of said point referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 5400.8 feet North and 2853.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2296, and running by true azimuths;-

1. 42° 31' 329.0 feet along South edge of 56 foot roadway;
2. 47° 49' 602.5 feet along same;
3. 327° 19' 558.5 feet along Lot 15;
4. 326° 50' 130.0 feet along Lot 15 to post marking the Southwest angle on top edge of pali of Kaholono gulch;
5. 269° 17' 969.9 feet along top edge of pali of said gulch to post marking the Southeast angle;
6. 147° 35' 655.7 feet along West edge of 56 foot roadway;
7. 153° 59' 735.0 feet along same to point of beginning.
