Revised Description.

Lot 14.

Hakalau Homesteads,
S. Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at an iron rail at the West corner of this lot, the North corner of Lot 15 and on the South side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 19560.4 feet North and 9343.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ²⁵⁷⁴~~2382~~, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 220° 00' 1050.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron pipe;
2. 269° 24' 345.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron pipe at the West corner of the Hakalau School Lot;
3. 355° 15' 435.0 feet along the Hakalau School lot to stream;
4. 84° 10' 375.0 feet along stream;
5. 48° 44' 763.2 feet along stream;
6. 146° 55' 200.0 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.

Area 9-75/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flumes, said right-of-way containing an area of 30/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 9-45/100 ACRES. Also Excepting and Reserving therefrom the stream and all riparian and other rights in or to this stream and the waters thereof.
