Beginning at a pipe at the Southeast corner of this lot, the Southwest corner of Lot 13 and on the North side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 2091.5 feet North and 1063.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $82^{\circ} 39' 30''$ 597.6 feet along North side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. $178^{\circ} 23'$ 968.9 feet along Lot 15 to a post 10 feet from the edge of a stream;
3. Easterly along a line parallel to ^{and} 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a post, the direct azimuth and distance being: $269^{\circ} 64'$ 520.5 feet;
4. $353^{\circ} 39'$ 900.0 feet along Lot 13 to the point of beginning.
