Beginning at a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot, the Northwest corner of Lot 15 and on the boundary of the lands of Kulaimano and Pepeekeo, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Alala" being 1419.0 feet South and 7207.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2497, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 123° 55' 514.0 feet along the top of the pali near the edge of the Waimaaua Gulch;
2. 360° 00' 1329.2 feet along Lot 13 to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe
3. 298° 05' 483.4 feet along road to a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 180° 00' 1270.0 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.
