Lot 14.

Beginning at the South corner of Grant 1532, Kamalii, at + on stone and ahu N 29° 6' E true 210 feet from Auhuhu Trig. Station and triangle mark, said Trig. Station being S 77° 42' 30" W true from Waiohinu Prot. Church Spire and its coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station being 9798.5 feet S. and 17616.0 feet E., as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. N 34° 10' W 958 feet along Grant 1532, Kamalii;
2. S 63° 57' W 843 feet along Lot 15;
3. S 25° 15' E 1973 feet along Lot 19 and crossing the Government road to a point 8-1/2 feet mauka of stone wall;
4. N 76° 8' E 577 feet along Grant 2787, W.C. Shipman, Lot 2;
5. S 34° 15' E 143 feet along the same along stone wall;
6. N 67° 10' E 676 feet along stone wall by Grant 2650, J. Kauhihiwa;
7. N 45° 40' W 1210 feet along stone wall by L.C.A. 7309, Kauhuakainui, and crossing the Government road to corner of stone wall;
8. N 36° 30' E 188 feet along the same;
9. N 34° 10' W 105 feet along Lot 13 to the initial point.
