Station "Papapaholahola" is by true azimuth and distance  $184^{\circ} 14'$  2888.8 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $97^{\circ} 27'$  800.0 feet along Lot 15 to a + on stone;
2.  $215^{\circ} 07'$  203.6 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
3.  $80^{\circ} 36'$  193.1 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
4.  $173^{\circ} 34'$  124.9 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
5.  $273^{\circ} 24'$  900.6 feet along Lot 13 to a + on stone;
6.  $3^{\circ} 24'$  310.0 feet along Lot 27 to the point of beginning.
