



Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, and the North corner of Lot 14-C, Waimea Government Remnants, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "Transit of Venus" being 585.1 feet North and 552.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2596, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 198° 11' 262.6 feet along government land along foot of pali;
2. 209° 08' 383.0 feet along same to a + on rock;
3. 317° 17' 170.9 feet along government land and along Lot 18, Waimea Government Remnants, to a pipe;
4. 2° 50' 114.5 feet along Lot 18, Waimea Government Remnants;
5. 37° 00' 120.0 feet along land deeded by Kamehameha IV to G. B. Rowell, dated November 30, 1857 and recorded in Book 10 Page 137;
6. 26° 30' 335.0 feet along same;
7. 108° 11' 165.2 feet along 30-foot roadway and along Lot 14-C, Waimea Government Remnants, to the point of beginning.
